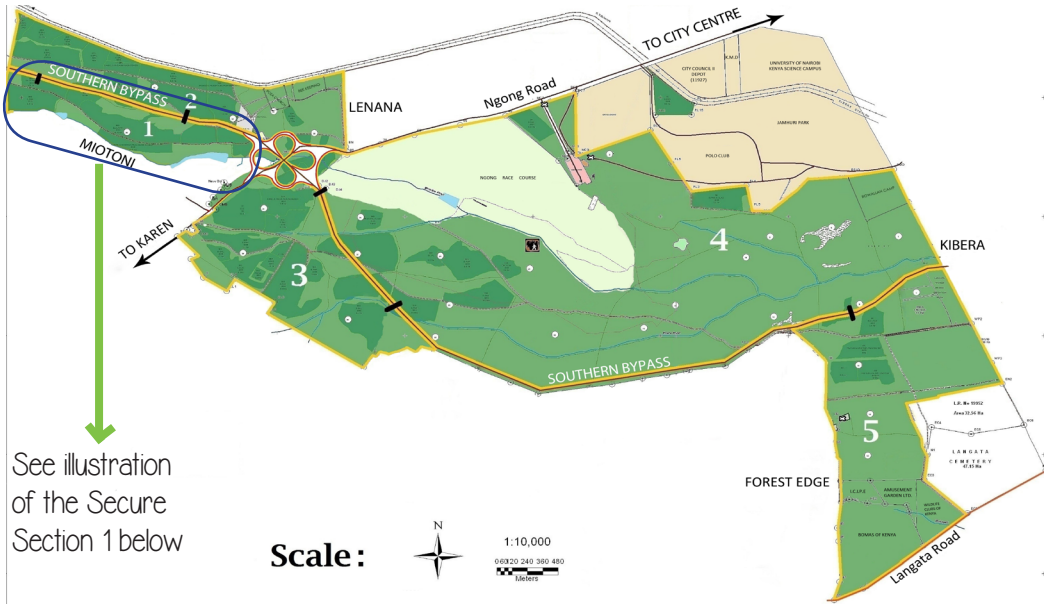

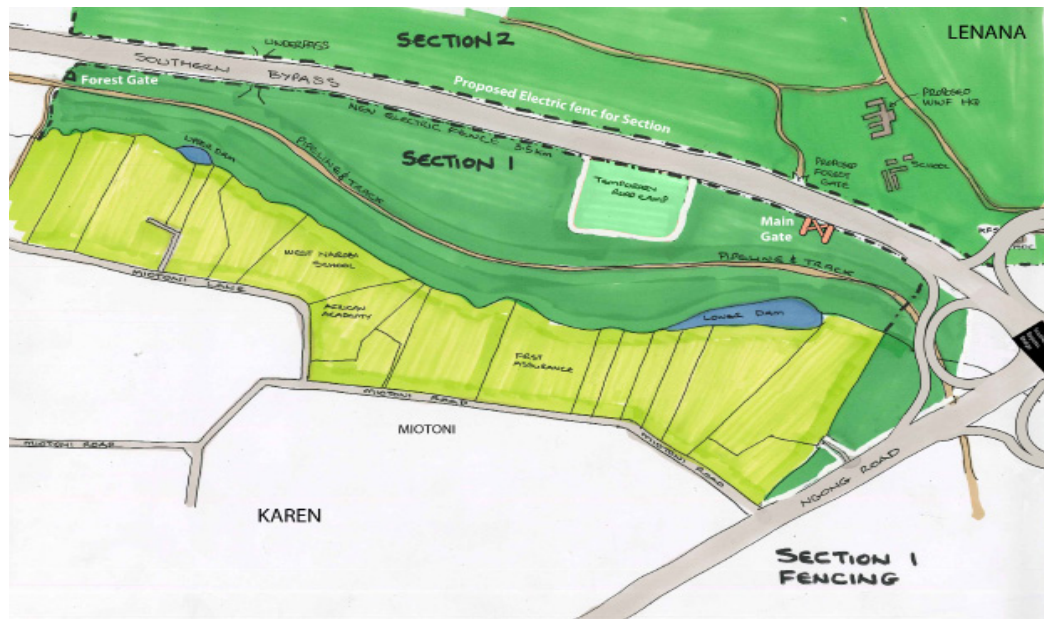


# THE NGONG ROAD FOREST

The Ngong Road Forest is an urban forest and caters for a wide clientele whose demands range from subsistence needs to recreation and aesthetics, for the poor and affluent respectively. It covers an area of 1224 ha. It is divided by the Ngong Road into two main sections, the Miotoni Section to the North West and the Racecourse and Kibera section to the South East. These sections in turn are divided by the Southern Bypass, which is nearing completion.



## The Plan

We are pleased to announce the opening of the secure Section 1 of the Ngong Road Forest. The vision of our plan is to continue securing the Ngong Road Forest, ensuring safety, and a world class example of sustainable forest management and conservation. The goal is to achieve and sustain a well conserved Ngong Forest through stakeholder's participation for provision of goods and services for the city residents.

## Objectives

Our objectives are:

- To make the Forest safe and secure for the enjoyment of all which will increase interest in preservation and conservation;
- To rehabilitate and manage Ngong Road Forest to a healthy and productive closed canopy forest;
- To protect the Forest from any high impact development other than forestry activities and ensure ecotourism proposals are in the best interest of the forest;
- To provide a world class example of sustainable participatory forest management and conservation
- To support the needs of local Communities;
- To promote environmental education, ecotourism and research in forestry;
- To have in place the necessary infrastructure, vehicles, machinery and equipment to sustain the management of the forest;
- To ensure plans are in place that provide the necessary human resources to implement and sustain the management plan.
